Information for Students and Families:

Tutorials

- Teachers and departments will communicate their tutorial schedules with all students

Exam Conflicts

- Students are expected to write their exams during the scheduled date/time. In the unlikely situation where a student has two exams in the same block, or an extenuating circumstance arises, accommodations may be made on a case-by-case basis in discussion with Ms. Yaschuk, Assistant Principal

Student Expectations:

- To arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the exam
- To show valid *photo* identification (student ID card, driver’s license, passport) to enter the exam writing space
- To come prepared with the necessary writing materials (e.g. pencil, eraser, highlighter, pen, whiteout, approved calculator, water bottle, snacks)
- To avoid bringing coats, hats, backpacks, cellphones, or electronic devices into the exam room
- To return textbooks prior to each exam
